IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT in relation to sentences in a municipal or police court  
or by a trial justice.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Whoever is convicted in a municipal or police  
2 court or by a trial justice of a crime, which is punishable by  
3 a fine, and is liable to imprisonment in a county jail for the  
4 non-payment of said fine, may be sentenced to pay said fine  
5 and the costs of prosecution, and in default of payment there-  
6 of to be imprisoned in accordance with law, but the payment  
7 of said fine and costs at any time before the expiration of the  
8 imprisonment shall be a full performance of the sentence.
