## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT in relation to sentences in a municipal or police court or by a trial justice.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Whoever is convicted in a municipal or police

- 2 court or by a trial justice of a crime, which is punishable by
- 3 a fine, and is liable to imprisonment in a county jail for the
- 4 non-payment of said fine, may be sentenced to pay said fine
- 5 and the costs of prosecution, and in default of payment there-
- 6 of to be imprisoned in accordance with law, but the payment
- 7 of said fine and costs at any time before the expiration of the
- 8 imprisonment shall be a full performance of the sentence.
