STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to prohibit the throwing of sawdust, shavings, waste or refuse into Little Ossipee river, within the limits of the towns of Shapleigh, Newfield, Waterboro, Limerick and Limington, in York county.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. No person shall cast or throw into the Little
2 Ossipee river, within the limits of the towns of Shapleigh,
3 Newfield, Waterboro, Limerick and Limington, in the county
4 of York, any sawdust, shavings, bark or other mill waste, or
5 place or deposit such mill waste or other refuse along the
6 banks in such manner that the same shall fall or be washed
7 into said waters.

Section 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this
2 act shall be subject to a penalty of not less than fifty nor
3 more than one hundred dollars and costs for each offense.
