STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to enlarge the jurisdiction of the municipal court of
Dexter.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section one of chapter one hundred and ninety
2 of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and
3 eighty-seven, is hereby amended, as follows: by striking
4 in out the fourth line the word "fifty" and inserting in its
5 place thereof the words 'one hundred,' so that said section
6 as amended shall read as follows:

'Section 1. In addition to its present jurisdiction, the said
8 court shall further have concurrent jurisdiction with the

9 supreme judicial court, in all personal actions where the
10 debt or damage claimed is over twenty dollars, and not over
11 one hundred dollars, and the defendant, or either of the
12 defendants or person or persons summoned as trustees, is
13 resident in said county of Penobscot; but this jurisdiction
14 shall not include proceedings under the divorce laws, or com-
15 plaints under the mill act, so called.'
