IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section 116 of chapter 6 of the Revised Statutes relating to caucuses in cities of over twenty-five thousand inhabitants.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Amend section 116 of chapter 6 of the Revised Statutes by 2 inserting the words 'the city committees may in their discre-3 tion determine in their call for a caucus or convention the 4 persons who are entitled to participate in said caucus or 5 convention' before the word "whenever" in the first line of 6 said section.
