STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE appropriating money for the purpose of obtaining information in regard to the wild lands for the purposes of taxation.

Resolved, That the sum of \$2,500.00 be and hereby is 2 appropriated for the year 1905, and a like sum for the year 3 1906, to be expended by the board of State assessors, under 4 the direction of the governor and council, for the purpose 5 of employing a competent person or persons whose duty it 6 shall be to assist said board in verifying and perfecting, as 7 far as practicable, a proper description of each parcel or 8 tract of wild land, and the individual or corporate owner-9 ship thereof, in townships not incorporated, in order that 10 such lands may be properly described for taxation purposes, 11 and for incorporating such description in deeds when lands

12 are sold for taxes; also for the employment of a competent
13 person or persons to assist said board of State assessors in
14 making special explorations in wild land townships to ascer15 tain for taxation purposes their just and fair value. Said
16 board in their regular report shall incorporate a report of
17 the work done under this resolve and a summarized state18 ment of their expenditures.
