Resolved, That there be appropriated and paid to Fred W.

3 and stenographer to the judiciary committee; and that there
4 be appropriated and paid to Harold E. Weeks the sum of
5 fifty dollars for services as messenger to the same committee.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Mr. Lee served as clerk and stenographer for the committee on judiciary, during the present session of the legislature, and this appropriation is to reimburse him for his duties. Harold E. Weeks served as clerk for the same committee and the appropriation of \$50 is to pay him for his services.
