RESOLVE in favor of the clerk and stenographer, and the messenger to the legal affairs committee.

Resolved, That there be appropriated and paid to Louis J. 2 Brann the sum of four hundred dollars for services as clerk 3 and stenographer to the committee on legal affairs; and that 4 there be appropriated and paid to E. Parker Craig the sum 5 of fifty dollars for services as messenger to the same com- 6 mittee.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Mr. Brann served as clerk and stenographer to the committee on legal affairs during the present session of the legislature, and the appropriation of \$400 is to pay him for his services. F. Parker Craig served as messenger to this committee and the appropriation of \$50 is to pay him for his services.
