IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to amend chapter 213 of the Private and Special Laws of 1903 authorizing the county commissioners of Cumberland county to erect a county building in Portland.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Chapter two hundred and thirteen of the Private and Special Laws of the year one thousand nine hundred and three is hereby amended by adding after the word "county" in the tenth line of the first paragraph thereof, the following: 'to an amount not to exceed in the aggregate six hundred thousand dollars, and the rate of interest on said bonds shall not exceed three and one-half per cent per

8 annum,' so that said paragraph as amended shall read as  
9 follows:

'The county commissioners of the county of Cumberland  
11 are authorized to erect and maintain in the city of Portland  
12 a county building of modern, fire proof construction, con-  
13 taining suitable court rooms, registries, county offices, library  
14 rooms and such other rooms, accommodations and con-  
15 veniences as to such commissioners may seem necessary or  
16 desirable, and for that purpose to acquire suitable land,  
17 either by purchase, exchange or by taking as for public uses,  
18 and in order to provide for the payment thereof to borrow  
19 money and issue interest bearing bonds of said county to an  
20 amount not to exceed in the aggregate six hundred thousand  
21 dollars, and the rate of interest on said bonds shall not  
22 exceed three and one-half per cent per annum. Said county  
23 commissioners shall cause any land so taken to be surveyed,  
24 located and so described that the same can be identified, and  
25 shall cause a plan and description thereof to be filed in their  
26 office and there recorded. The filing of said plan and  
27 description shall vest the title to said land in said county, or  
28 its grantees, to be held during the pleasure of said county.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
