STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the inmates of the Maine Insane
Hospital at Augusta.

In consideration of a bequest made in the will of the late
2 Helen A. Gilman, deceased, of the city of Portland, which
3 reads as follows :

“To the State of Maine one thousand dollars, to be held in
5 trust by the State treasurer for the promotion of the pleasure
6 and comfort of the patients in the State Hospital for the
7 insane at Augusta, upon the condition that a sum not less
8 than fifty dollars a year shall be appropriated by the legisla-
9 ture to be expended annually, as the income thereof, under
10 the direction of the trustees of the hospital, in the purchase
11 of such articles, or providing such entertainments as will
12 most conduce to the pleasure and benefit of the patients.

The foregoing bequest is to be paid in six months after my
14 decease.”

It is hereby directed and ordered by the legislature by joint
16 action of both branches, that after the sum of one thousand
17 (\$1,000) dollars is deposited with the State treasurer, the
18 sum of fifty (\$50) dollars shall be appropriated annually,
19 and paid the trustees of the Maine Insane Hospital at
20 Augusta, for the purposes set forth in said will and to be
21 used in the manner therein designated.
