IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section 112 of chapter 6 of the Revised Statutes relating to political caucuses.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 112 of chapter 6 of the Revised Statutes is hereby 2 amended by striking out in the second line the words "two 3 thousand" and the words 'one thousand' be substituted

4 therefor so that said section shall read as follows:

'Section 112. The provisions of the eleven preceding sec-6 tions shall not apply to towns of less than one thousand 7 inhabitants, nor to cities of more than thirty-five thousand 8 inhabitants, nor to cities wherein the calling and holding of 9 caucuses, is regulated by special law until such special law 10 is repealed.

This act shall take effect July 1, 1905.
