STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to exempt soldiers and sailors of the Civil War from
poll tax.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Every soldier or sailor who served in the army
2 or navy of the United States in the war of eighteen hundred
3 and sixty-one and who has an honorable discharge from such
4 service, resident within the State of Maine, be and is hereby
5 forever exempt from the assessment and payment of a poll
6 tax within any city, town or plantation in this State.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved by the
2 governor.
