IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to amend an act entitled An Act to to set off a part of plantation Number Seven and annex it to the town of Gouldsboro, of the Private and Special Laws of one thousand nine hundred and five, relating to the adjustment of their valuation.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The act entitled an act to set off a part of plantation Number Seven and annex it to the town of Gouldsboro is hereby amended as follows:

'Section 2. The valuation of said plantation Number 5 Seven as made by the State assessors in their valuation of 6 said plantation for the years one thousand nine hundred five 7 and six is hereby decreased and diminished by the sum of

8 five thousand dollars; and the valuation of the said town of
9 Gouldsboro as made by the said assessors in their valuation
10 of said town for the said years is hereby increased and raised
11 by the sum of five thousand dollars.'

Sect. 2. Section two of said act is hereby numbered and
2 constituted section three.
