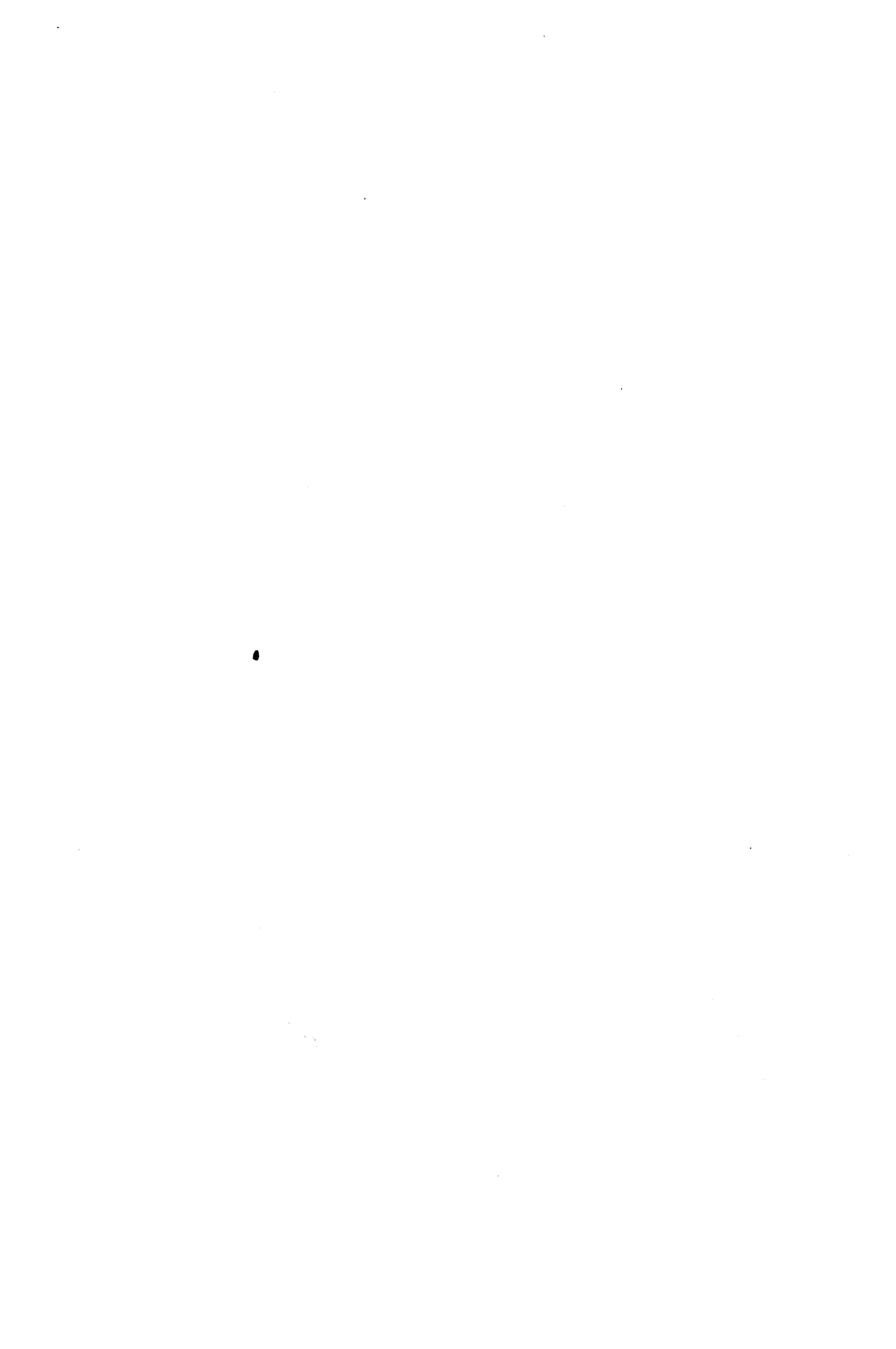

AN ACT for the protection of clams in parts of the county of
Sagadahoc.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

No clams shall be taken from the flats at Small Point Har-
2 bor or from Sprague's or Morses' rivers in the town of
3 Phippsburg, Sagadahoc county, excepting by the inhabitants
4 of the town or any person temporarily resident therein, who
5 may take therefrom for the immediate use of himself or his
6 family not exceeding one bushel at any one tide, or may sell
7 the same for consumption within the said town.
