### STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section 38 of chapter 41 of the Revised Statutes of Maine, relative to enforcement of penalty for illegal seining.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 38 of chapter 41 of the Revised Statutes of Maine

- 2 is hereby amended by striking out from said section the
- 3 words "in an" and substituting therefor the words 'by com-
- 4 plaint, indictment or' so that said section shall read as fol-5 lows:
- 'No person shall use any purse or drag seines in the follow-
- 7 ing waters: In Casco bay north of a line drawn easterly
- 8 from Prince's point in the town of Yarmouth to Bear Island
- 9 in the town of Phippsburg excepting for smelts, bluebacks

10 and spurling; in Kennebec river above a line drawn across II said river from Fort Popham in the town of Phippsburg to 12 a point opposite at the lower end of Long Island in the town 13 of Georgetown; in Sheepscot river above a bridge leading 14 from Wiscasset to Edgecomb; in Damariscotta river above 15 a line drawn from Farnum's head in the town of Boothbay 16 to a point opposite on the shore in the town of Bristol, 17 excepting the use of drag seines between the above line and 18 The Ledges, for all fish excepting alewives; in Medomak 19 river, above a line drawn from Martin's point in the town of 20 Friendship, westerly by the northeast end of Hog Island to 21 a point opposite in the town of Bremen, or take smelts in 22 said river and its tributaries in any other way than by hook 23 and line; in Georges river, above a line drawn from Hooper's 24 point in the town of St. George, westerly past the northly 25 end of Caldwell's island to a point opposite on the shore in 26 the town of Cushing, or take smelts in said river and its 27 tributaries in any other way than by hook and line, or dip-28 nets, and no individual shall take more than one-half bushel 29 of smelts within a period of twenty-four hours with dip-30 net; in all bays, inlets, rivers and harbors east of the west 31 shore of the Penobscot bay and river where any entrance to 32 the same or any part thereof from main land to main land 33 is not more than three nautical miles in width, but purse and 34 drag seines may be used for the purpose of taking smelts in 35 these waters, except in Bluehill bay. The taking of herring 36 or fishing therefor, by the use of purse or drag seines and all 37 other seines or nets, except the use of seines or nets in weirs, 38 from the first day of June to the first day of November in 39 the waters of Machias bay and its approaches inside of or to 40 the northward of a direct line drawn straight from the 41 highest summit of the island called The Brothers, easterly 42 to a point one-half mile distant and due south from Libby 43 island lighthouse, thence from said point easterly to the 44 southerly extremity of the southern island called Double 45 Head Shots, is hereby prohibited. The use of purse or 46 drag seines within a distance of one-half of a nautical mile 47 from any fish weir in any of the waters of the State east of 48 White Head on the west shore of Penobscot river is hereby 49 prohibited but such seines may be used for the taking of 50 smelts and for the purpose of taking fish in weirs but shall 51 not be used in any water in which their use is prohibited by 52 special or general law.'

Whoever violates any provision of this section shall be 54 liable to a penalty not exceeding five hundred dollars for 55 each offense, to be recovered by complaint, indictment or 56 action of debt.
