STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of Aroostook Normal School.

Resolved, That the sum of ten thousand dollars for the year
2 nineteen hundred and five and the like sum of ten thousand
3 dollars for the year nineteen hundred and six, be and hereby
4 is appropriated for the erection and furnishing of a dormi-
5 tory for Aroostook Normal School, said sums to be expended
6 under the direction of the board of trustees of State normal
7 schools.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Aroostook Normal School was instituted and located at Presque Isle by the legislature of 1903. The population of the village has increased so rapidly that there is a lack of tenements for those who wish to establish homes there. There are five acres of land in the lot upon which the normal school buildings are located, said buildings and grounds having been donated to the State by the town of Presque Isle.

It is becoming almost a uniform principle for normal schools to care for their students in dormitories.
