## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section fifty-seven of chapter eighty-four of the Statutes of Maine.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. Section fifty-seven of chapter eighty-four is
- 2 hereby amended by striking out the word "ten" and inserting
- 3 the word 'eight,' so that said section as amended shall read
- 4 as follows:

In all contracts for labor eight hours of actual labor are a

- 6 legal day's work, unless the contract stipulates for a longer
- 7 time, but this rule does not apply to monthly labor or to
- 8 agricultural employment.

This act shall take effect when approved.
