## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to amend chapter two hundred and twenty-seven of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty, entitled, "An Act to supply the people of Houlton with pure water," as amended by chapter four hundred and ninety-seven of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-nine, and as amended by chapter one hundred and forty-eight of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and three.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section two of said chapter two hundred and

- 2 twenty-seven as amended by said chapter four hundred and
- 3 ninety-seven of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen
- 4 hundred and eighty-nine and as amended by said chapter one
- 5 hundred and forty-eight of the Private and Special Laws

6 of nineteen hundred and three, is hereby further amended

7 by inserting after the word "hundred" in the seventh and

8 twelfth lines thereof the words 'and fifty.' So that said sec-

9 tion two as amended shall read as follows:

'Section 2. Said corporation may acquire and hold real and personal estate, necessary and convenient for the pur12 poses aforesaid, and the stock in whole or in part of the
13 Houlton Sewerage Company, not exceeding in all two hun14 dred thousand dollars; may sell and convey the same, may
15 issue certificates of stock to an amount not exceeding fifty
16 thousand dollars; and may issue and sell bonds to an amount
17 not exceeding one hundred and fifty thousand dollars, to aid
18 in the construction, extension, improvement and repairs of
19 its works, and to pay any existing debts whether represented
20 by bonds, notes or accounts, and for the purchase of the
21 whole or any part of the stock of the Houlton Sewerage
22 Company; and said bonds to the amount of one hundred and
23 fifty thousand dollars may be purchased and held by the
24 savings banks of Maine.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
