STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to authorize the Northern Maine Seaport Railroad to
locate across tide waters of Passagassawaukeag River.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The Northern Maine Seaport Railroad Com-
pany is hereby authorized and empowered to locate its rail-
road across the tide water of Passagassawaukeag River in
Belfast, and the railroad commissioners are hereby author-
ized to approve such location, provided, however, that said
railroad shall not be built over said tide water until the con-
sent thereto of the proper authorities of the United States
shall have been first obtained.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
