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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

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AN ACT to amend paragraph four of section one of chapter  
seventy-three of the Revised Statutes, relating to sales of real  
estate by license of court.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Paragraph four of section one of chapter  
2 seventy-three of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by  
3 adding thereto the following words: 'and of the guardian of  
4 an insane husband, resident in the county, to sell in like man-  
5 ner, the right and interest by descent, of such ward, in any  
6 real estate owned by his wife;' so that said paragraph as  
7 amended shall read as follows:

'IV. Of a husband or guardian of an insane wife resident  
9 in the county, to sell, on such terms and conditions as the

10 judge thinks proper, for a sufficient consideration, any real  
11 estate held by him in right of his wife, or any of her right  
12 and interest by descent in any real estate owned by him ; and  
13 of the guardian of an insane husband, resident in the county,  
14 to sell in like manner, the right and interest by descent, of  
15 such ward, in any real estate owner by his wife.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
