IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to amend chapter 407 of the Private and Special Laws  
of 1903, relating to fishing in Long pond, Hancock county.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section 1 of said chapter is hereby amended in  
2 the second and third lines of paragraph five in said section,  
3 entitled "In Hancock county," by striking out the words  
4 "and Long pond," so that said paragraph, as amended, shall  
5 read as follows:

'In Hancock county: Noyes' pond in Bluehill, Eagle lake,  
7 Bubble pond sometimes called Turtle lake, Jordan pond on  
8 Mt. Desert Island, Crocker pond and Pickerel pond in Town-  
9 ship 32, Middle division, Green lake, sometimes called Reed's  
10 pond, situated wholly or partly in Ellsworth, in which last

11 named lake it shall be lawful to fish, as provided in the gen-  
12 eral law, on Fridays and Saturdays of each week, during the  
13 months of February, March and April, of each year, and  
14 First or Billings pond in the town of Bluehill, in which last  
15 named pond the close time shall be from October first to May  
16 first of the following year.'
