STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to enable the Sebago Lake, Songo River and Bay of
Naples Steamboat Company to construct and maintain a
wharf at the foot of Long lake in the town of Naples in the
county of Cumberland.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

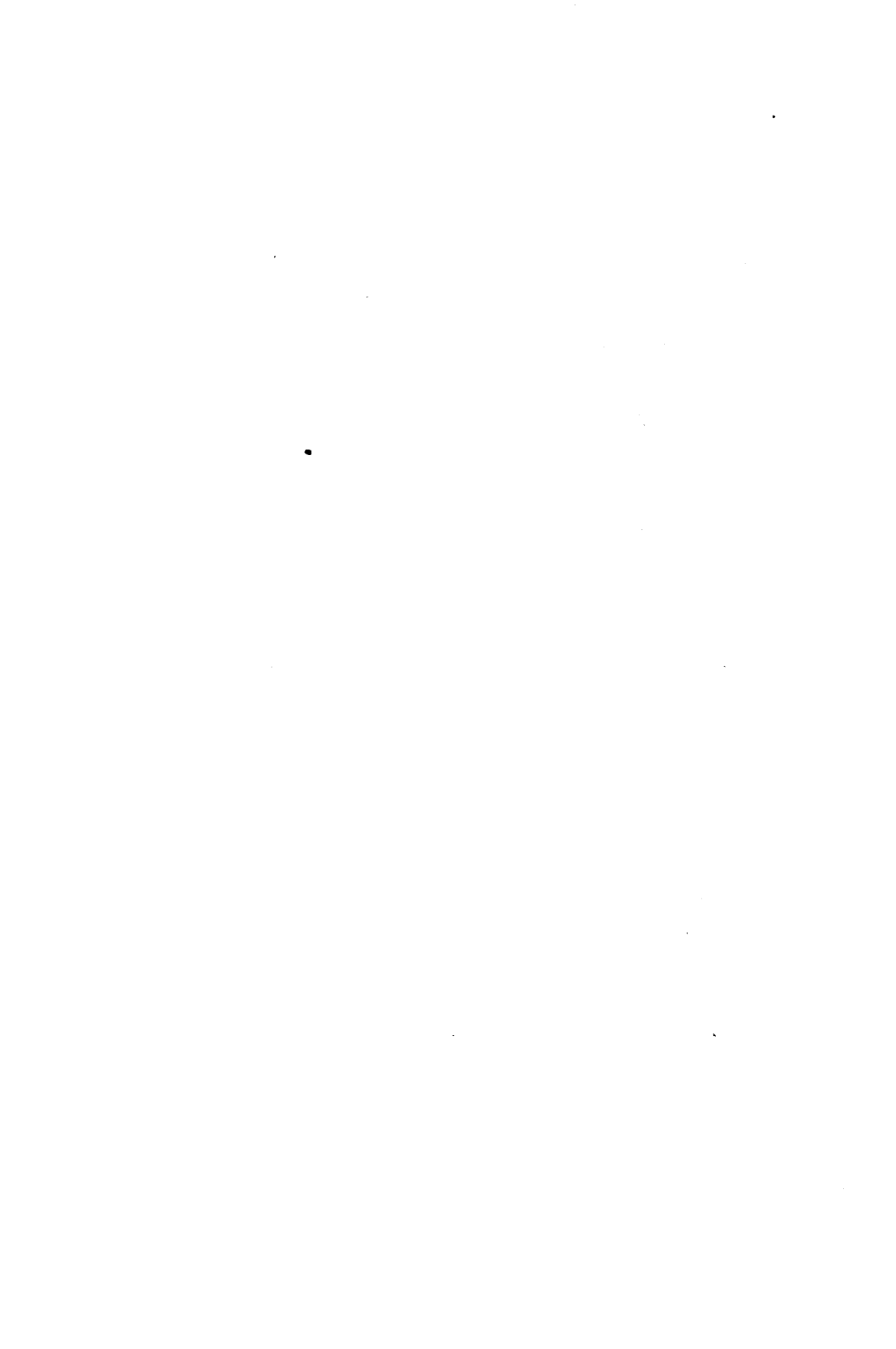
Section 1. The Sebago Lake, Songo River and Bay of
2 Naples Steamboat Company, a corporation duly established
3 and existing under the laws of the State, its successors and
4 assigns, are hereby authorized and empowered to construct
5 and maintain a wharf at the foot of Long lake in the town
6 of Naples, in the county of Cumberland and on the southerly
7 side of what is known as Long Pond bridge, and adjoining

8 the easterly abutment of said bridge, and to extend the same
9 at a sufficient length and width into the water to allow the
10 landing of boats and steamers at said wharf.

Sect. 2. And for the purposes aforesaid the said corpo-
2 ration is hereby authorized to acquire by purchase, grant or
3 gift, from any person or corporation, any lands, shore rights,
4 rights of way from streets or highways to said wharf; said
5 corporation may also for the purposes aforesaid, take, by
6 right of eminent domain, any land, shore rights, rights of
7 way from streets or highways to said wharf, in the same
8 manner and under the same conditions, restrictions and
9 limitations, as are by law prescribed in the case of taking land
10 for the laying out of highways, upon payment of reasonable
11 compensation therefor.

Sect. 3. Said corporation shall be held liable to pay a
2 just compensation for the taking of the lands, shore rights,
3 rights of way from streets or highways to said wharf, and
4 if any person sustaining damage for property so as afore-
5 said taken, and said corporation shall not mutually agree
6 upon the sum to be paid therefor, such person may cause his
7 damages to be ascertained in the same manner and under the
8 same conditions, restrictions and limitations, as are by law
9 prescribed in the case of damages by the laying out of high-
10 ways.

Sect. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
