STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Maine Midland Railroad Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. Section thirteen of chapter one hundred and
- 2 thirty-eight of the Private and Special Laws for nineteen
- 3 hundred and three is hereby amended so as to read as
- 4 follows:
- 'Section 13. Said corporation shall organize and the loca-
- 6 tion of the railroad according to actual survey shall be filed
- 7 with the county commissioners of Franklin county and of
- 8 Androscoggin county on or before the first day of February,
- 9 nineteen hundred and seven, and the said corporation shall
- 10 be and hereby is given until the first day of April, nineteen

- 11 hundred and nine, within which to build and operate its said 12 railroad.'
 - Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
