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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

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AN ACT to amend section seventeen of chapter fifty-three of  
the Revised Statutes relating to Street Railroads.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section seventeen of chapter fifty-three of the  
2 Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding the words  
3 'and to other points or places not so named' after the word  
4 "association" in line four of said section, so that said section  
5 as amended shall read as follows:

'Section 17. Any street railroad corporation in this State  
7 may be authorized to extend, construct, maintain and operate  
8 its road to, into and through cities and towns other than  
9 and in addition to those named in its charter or articles of  
10 association, and to other points or places not so named, on

11 application to the board of railroad commissioners, and by  
12 compliance with and subject to the provisions of section  
13 seven of this chapter; the right of any connecting street rail-  
14 road company specially conferred upon it by its charter shall  
15 be preserved unimpaired.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
