STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to authorize the Northern Telegraph Company to extend its lines along the Northern Maine Seaport Railroad, and to increase its capital stock.

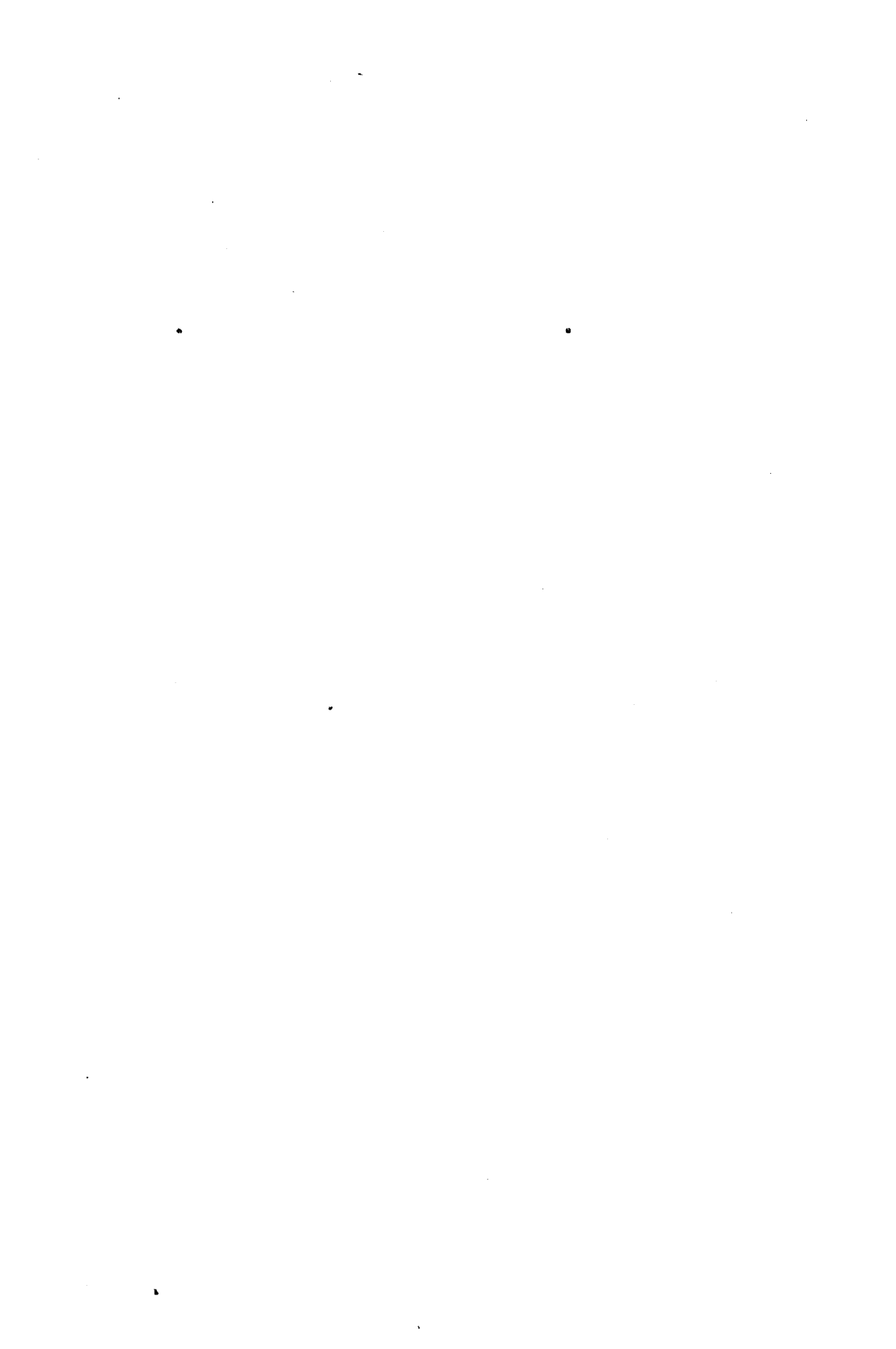
Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The Northern Telegraph Company, in addition
2 to the telegraph lines which it now operates, is hereby
3 authorized and empowered to extend, build, maintain and
4 operate its line to, into and through the same cities and towns,
5 to, into and through which the Northern Maine Seaport
6 Railroad Company may now or hereafter be located.

Sect. 2. Section 4 of chapter 186 of the Private and Special
2 Laws of 1879, is hereby amended by changing the word
3 "one" in the second line thereof to 'two,' so that said section,
4 as amended, shall read as follows:

'Section 4. The capital stock of said company shall be
6 fixed by the by-laws thereof, but not to exceed two hundred
7 thousand dollars.'

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
