STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Maine Water and Electric
Power Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The time within which the Maine Water and
2 Electric Power Company shall actually commence business
3 under its charter is hereby extended to two years from the
4 approval of this act; provided, however, this act shall be null
5 and void unless the sum of five thousand dollars is expended
6 before the next session of the legislature in the development
7 and improvement of the water power under the charter of
8 said company; and provided, further, that three thousand of
9 said five thousand dollars shall be expended on or before
10 March fifteenth, one thousand nine hundred and six.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
