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## STATE OF MAINE.

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RESOLVE in favor of John Chadwick and Company to aid  
navigation on Mooselookmeguntic Lake.

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*Resolved,* That the sum of one hundred dollars is hereby  
2 appropriated to be paid to John Chadwick and Company to  
3 reimburse it in part for its expenditure in erecting buoys as  
4 guides to navigation in the narrows near Upper dam on  
5 Mooselookmeguntic lake.

Said sum shall be paid to said company on the delivery to  
7 the governor and council of a certificate signed by one of the  
8 steamboat inspectors, setting forth that said buoys have been  
9 erected at the place and in the manner approved by him.



### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

John Chadwick and Company on account of the drawing of the water from Mooselookmeguntic lake by the Union Water Power Company under an act of the legislature, have been compelled to place buoys in said lake to aid the navigation of the same. This is especially true of that section of the lake near the Upper dam. The amount called for in the resolve is but a small part of the money actually expended by John Chadwick and Company on the lake, and they ask for this amount only as payment for work that aids all navigation on said lake.
