#### RESOLVE for State Pensions.

Resolved, That the sum of eighty-seven thousand five hun-

- 2 dred dollars be and is hereby appropriated to provide for
- 3 State pensions for invalid soldiers and sailors, their widows
- 4 and orphans, and the dependent children, parents and sisters
- 5 of deceased soldiers and sailors eligible thereto under exist-
- 6 ing law, for the year nineteen hundred and five, and eighty-
- 7 seven thousand five hundred dollars for the year nineteen
- 8 hundred and six.
