STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to preserve the purity of the source of water supply
for the villages of Livermore Falls and Chisholm, and to protect
the public health.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. No structure, cess-pool, privy or outhouse
2 shall hereafter be erected or maintained within the distance
3 of three hundred feet of the waters of Moose Hill pond, so
4 called, in the town of East Livermore in the county of
5 Androscoggin, the source of the water supply for the villages
6 of Livermore Falls and Chisholm.

Sect. 2. No sewage, drainage, refuse or polluting matter
2 of such kind and amount as either by itself or in connection
3 with other matter will corrupt or impair the quality of the

4 water of said Moose Hill pond, or render it injurious to
5 health, shall be discharged into said pond, or put upon the
6 ice thereon, but nothing herein shall prohibit the cultivation
7 and use of the soil in the ordinary methods of agriculture if
8 no human excrement is used thereon within three hundred
9 feet of the shores of said pond.

Sect. 3. The supreme judicial court shall have jurisdiction
2 in equity to enjoin, prevent or restrain any violation of the
3 provisions of this act.

Sect. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
