STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE authorizing the compilation and publication of the
Insurance Laws of Maine.

Resolved, That the sum of one hundred dollars be and
2 hereby is appropriated for the purpose of compiling the insur-
3 ance and fraternal beneficiary laws of the State, and the insur-
4 ance commissioner is hereby authorized to make such com-
5 pilation and cause two thousand copies of the same to be
6 printed and bound for the use of his department.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

It has been the practice of the insurance commissioner for many years, under legislative authority, to compile and publish from time to time for free distribution the statutes of this State relating to insurance.

The last compilation was in 1901 and the edition is nearly exhausted and owing to the revision of 1903 is out of date. The department is receiving many calls from the citizens of this State and others for copies of the laws relating to insurance and fraternal beneficiary associations, which it is unable to supply, and a new revision is absolutely necessary.
