
AN ACT additional to chapter one hundred and forty-four of the Revised Statutes relating to insane hospitals.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The trustees of insane hospitals are hereby 2 authorized, subject to the approval of the governor and coun3 cil, to appoint a treasurer for either of the insane hospitals,
4 other than the steward of either hospital, and to fix the salary
5 of said treasurer. Said treasurer shall give bond to the
6 trustees, in such amount and with such sureties as they deem
7 sufficient for the safe keeping and proper disbursement of
8 the funds of the institution at which he is located; perform
9 such other duties as the trustees direct; and annually make a
10 detailed report to them of his receipts and expenditures and
