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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

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AN ACT authorizing West Harbor Ice Company to construct  
a fishway and to protect alewives in West Harbor Ice pond  
and its tributaries.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The West Harbor Ice Company of Boothbay  
2 Harbor is hereby authorized and empowered to construct  
3 and maintain a fishway around or over their dam from tide  
4 waters to the water of its Ice pond.

Sect. 2. No person shall take alewives from the waters of  
2 West Harbor Ice pond and its tributaries, or in either of the  
3 ponds having an outlet into said pond, or any fishway con-  
4 structed by the West Harbor Ice Company or in the tide  
5 waters within one hundred feet of such fishway for a period

6 of five years. Whoever takes alewives contrary to the pro-  
7 visions of this section shall be fined ten dollars for each  
8 offence to be recovered by complaint, indictment or action of  
9 debt.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
