RESOLVE in favor of Aroostook Normal School at
Presque Isle.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum
2 of three thousand dollars for the Aroostook Normal School
3 at Presque Isle, the same to be expended by and under the
4 direction of the trustees of the normal schools of the State.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

In repairing and fitting for occupancy the buildings accepted by the State from the town of Presque Isle for the use of the Aroostook Normal School, it was found that, in order to preserve the property of the State, it became necessary to expend the sum of twenty-five hundred dollars in excess of the amount appropriated by the legislature of 1903 for that purpose. In addition to this it is represented herewith that the needs of the school require a piano and musical appliances at a total cost of five hundred dollars.
