RESOLVE in favor of Seboeis road.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum
2 of sixty-one dollars and twelve cents to reimburse H. P.
3 Gardner, agent, for the amount expended by him more than
4 the appropriation.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The legislature of nineteen hundred and three appropriated five hundred dollars for repairs on Seboeis road with the condition that an equal amount for the same purpose be raised by subscription. This amount was subscribed and the amount expended on the Seboeis road during the seasons of nineteen hundred and three and four. The amount was overdrawn in labor orders to the amount of sixty-one dollars and twelve cents, for which vouchers are furnished.
