STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in aid of navigation on Schoodic Grand Lake.

Resolved, That the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars is
2 hereby appropriated for placing and maintaining buoys in
3 Schoodic Grand lake in Aroostook county. Said buoys shall
4 be placed at such points on said waters as will best serve the
5 needs of navigation thereof. All said money to be expended
6 under the direction of the State steamboat inspectors.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This is one of our largest lakes. The traffic upon it has **increased** to such an extent that the public safety requires that **the** dangerous shoals and boulders be defined so that the safety **of the** public shall be better protected.
