STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to fix the salary of the Governor.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. On and after January first, nineteen hundred
2 and seven, the salary of the governor shall be three thousand
3 dollars a year, payable quarterly on the first days of January,
4 April, July and October.
