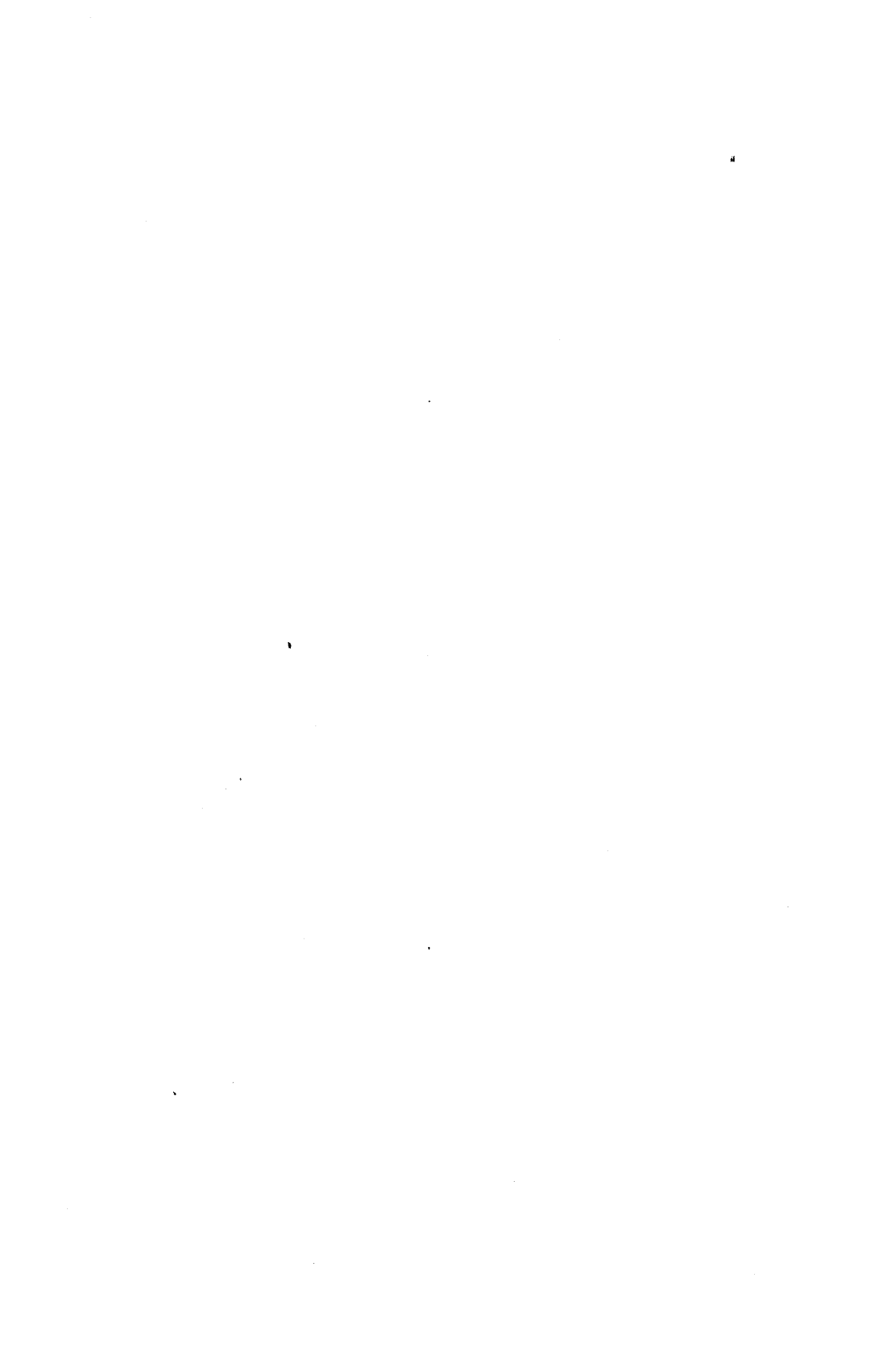

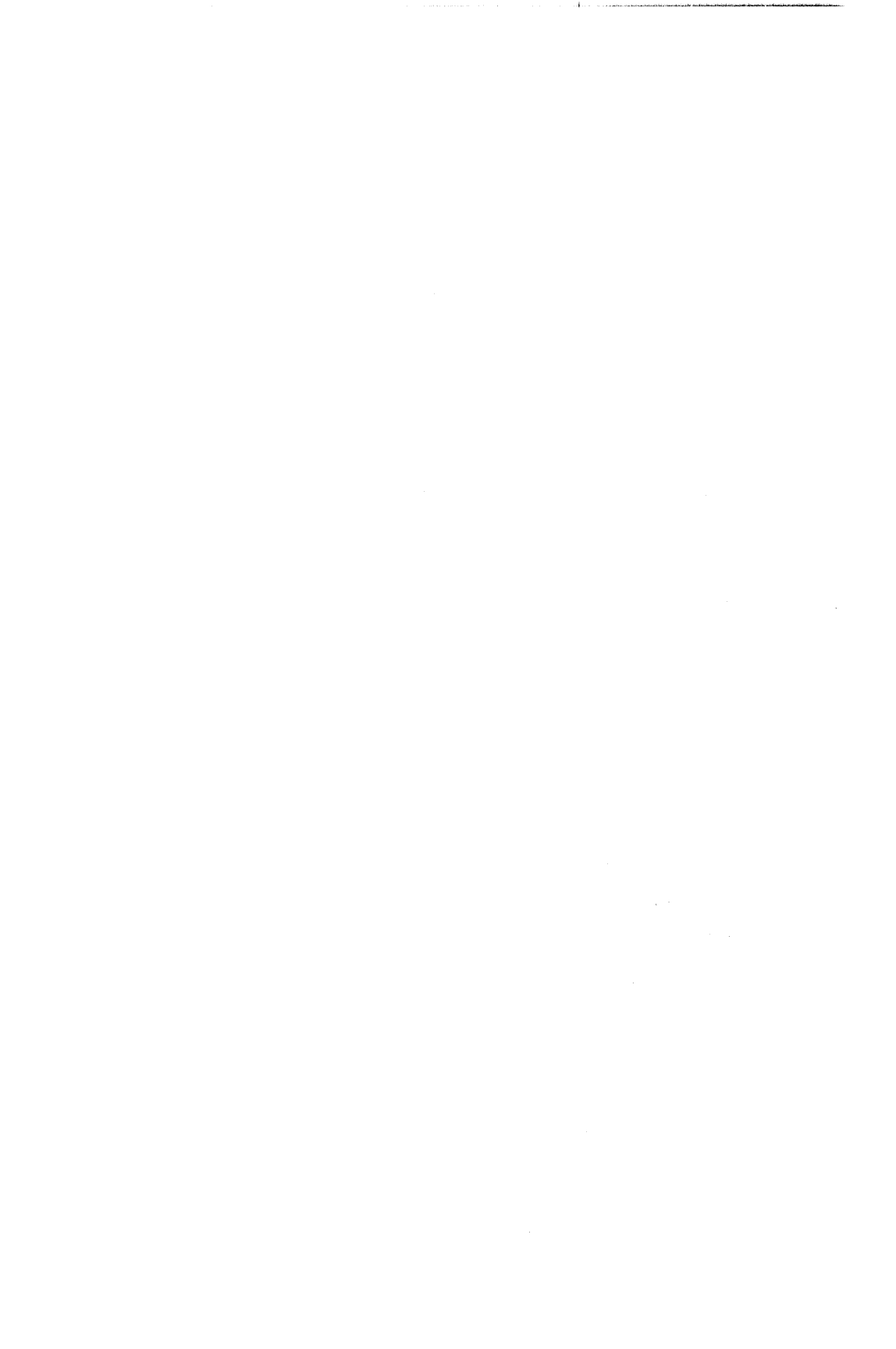
AN ACT to extend the powers of the trustees of Bangor
Theological Seminary.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The trustees of Bangor Theological Seminary
2 are hereby authorized and empowered to confer degrees in
3 divinity upon such of its graduates, and upon such other
4 persons, as may be determined by said trustees to be suitable
5 candidates for such degrees.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
