STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to enable William G. Barter to construct and maintain weirs near Whitmore's cove in the waters of Penobscot bay.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. William G. Barter of Deer Isle is hereby
- 2 authorized and empowered to construct and maintain weirs
- 3 in the tide waters of Penobscot bay near Whitmore's cove,
- 4 so called, southerly from Stinson's Neck bar and easterly of
- 5 Eaton's point, so called, in the town of Deer Isle, adjoining
- 6 the land of said William G. Barter.
 - Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
