STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to grant administration on the estate of John A.
Holmes, late of Readfield.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The judge of probate for and within the county
2 of Kennebec, is hereby authorized and empowered to grant
3 administration on the estate of John A. Holmes, late of
4 Readfield, in the county of Kennebec, deceased, at any time
5 within thirty years from the decease of the said Holmes.

Sect. 2. An administrator appointed under this act shall
2 have the same authority and be subject to the same liabilities
3 as an administrator appointed under the general laws of this
4 State.

Sect. 3. Any provision of the Revised Statutes in regard
2 to the time when administration may be granted shall not
3 debar or hinder the granting of administration on the estate
4 of the said John A. Holmes.

Sect. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
