IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to authorize the inhabitants of York to give the York
Hospital a tract of land.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The inhabitants of York are hereby authorized
2 to give the York Hospital a certain tract of land to be used
3 in establishing a hospital in said town for the treatment of
4 persons requiring the aid of medical or surgical skill care and
5 attendance.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
