AN ACT to extend the charter of the Ellsworth Street Railway

Company.


Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Ells-

- 2 worth Street Railway Company which were granted by chap-
- 3 ter three hundred ninety-one of the Private and Special Laws
- 4 for the year eighteen hundred eighty-nine, as extended and
- 5 enlarged by chapter five hundred fifteen of the Private and
- 6 Special Laws for the year eighteen hundred ninety-three,
- 7 chapter eighty-one of the Private and Special Laws for the
- 8 year eighteen hundred ninety-five, chapter four hundred
- 9 fifty-six of the Private and Special Laws for the year
- 10 eighteen hundred ninety-seven, chapter one hundred thirty-
- 11 three of the Private and Special Laws for the year eighteen

12 hundred ninety-nine, chapter two hundred sixty-seven of the 13 Private and Special Laws for the year nineteen hundred one, 14 and chapter one hundred five of the Private and Special 15 Laws for the year nineteen hundred three, are hereby 16 extended for two years additional, and the persons named 17 in said acts, their associates and successors, shall have the 18 rights, powers and privileges that were granted to them by 19 said acts, to be exercised by them for the same purposes 20 as specified in said acts.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
