STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT providing for open season on white perch in Lake St. George, Waldo county.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Sect. 1. There shall be an open time for white perch in
- 2 Lake St. George, situated in Waldo county, from June first
- 3 of each year to April first of the following year.
 - Sect. 2. It shall be unlawful for any person during the
- 2 month of June of any year to take, catch, or kill more than
- 3 eight pounds of white perch in any one day in said pond, and
- 4 only for consumption in his own family.
 - Sect. 3. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this act
- 2 shall be subject to the penalties provided in the general law
- 3 against illegal fishing.
