AN ACT granting permission to John L. Goss to construct and maintain a bridge across Moose Island Bar in the town of Stonington.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section I. Permission is hereby granted to John L. Goss
- 2 to construct and maintain a bridge across Moose Island Bar
- 3 in the town of Stonington, Hancock county.
- Sect. 2. Said bridge shall at all times be open to the public 2 and no toll shall be charged for its use.
