

STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of L. C. Morse.

Resolved, That the sum of one hundred one dollars and
2 eighty cents be and hereby is appropriated to be paid to L. C.
3 Morse for expenses and cash paid out on the joint special
4 committee appointed by the legislature of nineteen hundred
5 and three for the purpose of inquiring into the advisability
6 of establishing a "Home for the Feeble Minded" of the State.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Mr. Morse was a member of the joint special committee appointed by the legislature of 1903 for the purpose of inquiring into the advisability of establishing a home for the feeble minded and this resolve re-imburses him for personal expenses and cash paid out as a member of said committee.
