RESOLVE in favor of R. D. Leavitt of Auburn.

Resolved, That the sum of ninety dollars and ninety-two 2 cents (\$90.92) be and hereby is appropriated to be paid to 3 R. D. Leavitt of Auburn to re-imburse him for expenses 4 while attending hearings of the Special Committees on Sala-5 ries and Fees.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Mr. Leavitt was a member of the joint special committee appointed by the legislature of 1903 for the purpose of inquiring into the amount of compensation received by all State and county officials whose salaries are determinable by the legislature, and this resolve re-imburses him for personal expenses and cash paid out as a member of said committee.
