RESOLVE in favor of L. M. Staples.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated to be
2 paid to L. M. Staples the sum of eighty-nine dollars and
3 nine cents (\$89.09) for expenses and cash paid out as com-
4 missioner to investigate and report on Institution of Feeble
5 Minded in Maine, as appointed by the last legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Mr. Staples was a member of the joint special committee appointed by the legislature of 1903 for the purpose of inquiring into the advisability of establishing a Home for the Feeble Minded, and this resolve reimburses him for personal expenses and cash paid out as a member of said committee.
