
AN ACT to extend the charter of Union River Water Storage Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Union

- 2 River Water Storage Company which were granted by
- 3 chapter 325 of the Private and Special Laws of the State of
- 4 Maine for the year 1901, as extended and enlarged by chap-
- 5 ter 198 of the Private and Special Laws for the year 1903,
- 6 are hereby extended for two years additional, and the persons
- 7 named in said act, their associates and successors, shall have
- 8 all the rights, powers and privileges that were granted to
- 9 them by said acts, to be exercised in the same manner and 10 for the same purposes specified in said acts.
 - Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
