STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT relating to the Bar Harbor and Union River Power
Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The Bar Harbor and Union River Power Com-
2 pany is hereby authorized and empowered to issue its bonds
3 for the carrying out of any of its purposes to an amount not
4 exceeding the sum of one million two hundred and fifty thou-
5 sand dollars, instead of to an amount not exceeding the sum
6 of one million dollars as now provided by law, said bonds
7 (including the increase in issue hereby authorized) to be on
8 such rates and time as it may deem expedient, and it may

9 secure the payment of principal and interest on such bonds
10 by appropriate mortgages or deeds of trust of all or any part
11 of its property, franchises, rights and privileges now owned
12 or to be hereafter acquired by it.

Sect. 2. Said company is authorized to change the amount
2 of its capital stock and the number of its directors from time
3 to time in the same manner and under the same terms as
4 provided by law applicable to similar corporations organized
5 under the general law. Any changes so heretofore made are
6 hereby ratified and confirmed.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
