## STATE OF MAINE.

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to extend the corporate powers of the Sebasticook Manufacturing and Power Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section I. The acts of the Sebasticook Manufacturing and

- 2 Power Company in changing its corporate name to Sebasti-
- 3 cook Water Power Company are hereby made valid.
  - Sect. 2. Said corporation is hereby authorized to sell, dis-
- 2 tribute and supply electricity, for power purposes only, but
- 3 not for lighting, in that part of Winslow bounded by the
- 4 boundary line between Benton and Winslow, the Kennebec
- 5 river, the road leading from the Waterville and Winslow

- 6 bridge into Winslow, and the Kennebec river road leading 7 from said last described road to said boundary line.
- Sect. 3. Said corporation is hereby authorized to set poles 2 and extend wires thereon in and through such streets and
- 3 ways of Benton and of Winslow as it may deem most expe-
- 4 dient in carrying out the purposes of section two of this act,
- 5 under such reasonable restrictions as the municipal officers
- 6 of said towns may impose as to the kind of poles, the manner
- 7 in which they shall be set and the height at which the wires
- 8 shall be carried thereon.
- Sect. 4. Nothing herein contained shall affect any action,
- 2 at law or in equity, now pending, or any cause of action, at
- 3 law or in equity, heretofore accrued.
  - Sect. 5. No land shall hereafter be taken by said company,
- 2 for the erection of posts and wires to be used for the trans-
- 3 mission of electricity to be used in the town of Winslow.
  - Sect. 6. Section two of chapter two hundred and seventy-
- 2 one of the Private and Special Laws for the year nineteen
- 3 hundred and three is hereby repealed.
  - Sect. 7. This act shall take effect when approved.
