STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE authorizing the land agent to release the State's
interest in Half Way Island in Hancock county.

Resolved, That the State land agent be and he is hereby
2 authorized and empowered upon payment of a nominal con-
3 sideration of one dollar to make, execute and deliver a good
4 and sufficient deed, releasing to Edward B. Mears of Eden
5 in the county of Hancock, Maine, his heirs and assigns, all
6 the right, title and interest which the State of Maine has in
7 and to a certain island situated in Upper Branch pond in the
8 city of Ellsworth, near the center of the northern shore of
9 said pond, and formerly known as Half Way island but more
10 recently called Salisbury's island.
